Parent Code of Conduct

Parents play an import role in the development of a successful soccer/futsal player. Parents MUST be a positive influence in the soccer/futsal experience. Parents will do this by:

1. Encouraging good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or team function.
2. You will not enter the court during a game, scrimmage, training session, or practice unless otherwise asked to do so by the coach.
3. You will not verbally or physically abuse, confront, taunt, harass, or demean a coach, student athlete, opposing student-athlete, another parent, or a referee at any time.
4. You understand that parents cannot coach their child or other student-athletes from the sideline or anywhere else during scrimmages, practices, training sessions, or games.
5. You will make every effort to allow your child to attend all practices, training sessions, games, tournaments, and team functions.
 - a. You will call in or e-mail the coach to inform him or her that your child will not be in attendance. You will need to have an excused absence authorized by the coach in order to miss practice, training, or a game.
6. You will abide by the “24 hour rule” which means not speaking to your coach, director, or other parents about the game or your player’s playing time within 24 hours after the game.
 - a. After the “24 hour rule”, you may call the coach and speak over the phone with him or her or set up an appointment to meet with the coach and address your concerns regarding the program.
 - b. If you are not satisfied following the meeting with the coach, you may go to the director to discuss your concerns. The director will not address concerns until after consulting with the coach.
7. During practice and training sessions, you will remain in the lobby or observation area upstairs in the gym. All practices and training sessions are closed to spectators, parents, and children not participating in that particular session.

Parent Financial Responsibility

City FC Club season runs from July 9th, 2018 - May 23rd, 2019. When you commit to participating, you are committing to the entire season, unless otherwise approved by the owner.

Membership Dues:

- A. **Membership:** \$150 payment must be made on Signing day, July 1st-3rd, 2018.
- Membership includes all necessary player cards for competition.

Training Dues:

Premier Jr. Academy Dues (11'): \$1,680
Premier Academy Dues (10', 09'): \$2,500
Premier Select Academy Dues (08', 07'): \$3,000
Premier Select Dues (06', 05', 04', 03'): \$3,000

- B. **Full Payment Option:** Pay tuition in full by July 15th, 2018, by check or credit card.
- C. **Installment Option:** Pay tuition on a monthly basis using your online membership account.
**Installment option is a nine-month plan automatically withdrawn on the 15th of each month.*
NOTE: *Membership Dues + 1st months Training dues are paid at signing.*

- D. **FDSP 2018 - 2019:** \$1,100 - *optional, please check the box if you will be participating.
- E. **Late Payment:** If your monthly online account payment is declined and not resolved 5 days after the due date, your player will be allowed to attend trainings & games, but will not be allowed to participate.
- F. **Work Program:** Parents participating in a work program will have their account credited for the amount received from the work program on the 15th of every month. Account may not be left unpaid when due because money from the work program is expected to be received at a later date.
- G. **Payment Obligation:** If at any time during the season, you remove your student-athlete from City FC, you will be financially responsible to pay for the remainder of the season. If any payments above are not paid and collection services are necessary, City FC will also attempt to recover any and all costs and fees incurred as a result of collections, including reasonable attorney fees and costs.

As a condition of enrollment, the following disclaimer of liability must be signed and dated by the participant's parent or legal guardian. The parent or guardian of the participant is permitting the participant to participate and recognizes that he/she is doing so at his/her own risk. City FC and its officers, agents, and staff shall not be liable for any damages arising from personal injury sustained by the participant while at or on the way to and from any activity. The participant and his or her parent or guardians assume full responsibility for any damages or injuries which may occur to the participant during the season and so hereby full and forever exonerate and discharge City FC, its officers, agents, and staff from any and all claims, demands, damages, rights of action or causes of action, present or future, whether the same be known, participated, or unanticipated, resulting from or arising out of the participants participation in the program, I understand that soccer/futsal is a potentially risky activity in which my child might be injured severely. This includes death. I, therefore, release any and all City FC staff members from liability of any kind of injury to my child, however serious it may be, because of the connection with the activity. I/we allow the use of my/our likeness for the program publicity. City FC reserves the right to use any photos or video taken during clinics, camps, training sessions, workouts, practice, tournaments, travel tournaments, etc.
